Dear AACT member:

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Fellow of the American Academy of Clinical Toxicology (AACT). Fellow designation (FAACT) recognizes clinical toxicologists for exceptional service to the Academy and to the field of clinical toxicology. Fellow designation criteria require a minimum of four years of professional involvement in clinical toxicology, as well as four years of AACT membership.

FAACT designation criteria have been extensively revised in recent years, including allowing the years of a toxicology fellowship training program to count toward the required four years of AACT membership and as years in toxicology practice. In addition, service to AACT-related activities at NACCT meetings and service to the journal *Clinical Toxicology* count as AACT core services. In considering your application, please identify a current AACT Fellow who can nominate you. This person should know you well, and be able to discuss your eligibility with the Committee Chair (or designee) prior to submitting the application or additional letters of recommendation.
